is a 4 day/3 night stay designed for Wolf, Bear and Webelos Cub Scouts who are prepared to experience an overnight camp! A Scout will stay with his friends in either 2 man tent sites, larger tent condos or in Macaleer Lodge with bunk beds.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

All Cub Scouts and Webelos Cubs Scouts may attend camp with their pack. Parents are encouraged to come with leaders and enjoy the camping experience with their sons. No previous camping experience is needed. If you bring your personal equipment and your Scout spirit, our trained staff will take care of the rest.

FAMILY CAMP WEEKEND . . .

is designed for spending quality time with any and all members of your family. It is the perfect 24-hour program for "new" campers as well as seasoned veterans. Participants are only responsible for providing outdoor personal gear.

When you arrive you will find your tent set up, ready and waiting for you. All you have to do is show up and move into your temporary home-away-from-home in the great outdoors!

This program is open to all Tiger, Wolf, Bear, and Webelos Scouts.

A Scout can attend Family weekend with their mom, dad, legal guardian, and/or adult relative (18 years or older) as well as all of their siblings.

The adventure begins on Saturday with sessions in nature, games, swimming, handicrafts, archery, BB, Scout skills and tons of fun. Sunday includes a full breakfast, a "Scout's Own Service" and a closing ceremony.

The program is limited to 250 participants per weekend with overflow registrants placed on a waiting list. Payment must be made with your reservation.

is a daytime camp conducted over 5 days. It is an outdoor adventure away from the usual den & pack setting. Cub Scouts will participate in fun and exciting activities that may include: nature, hiking, sports, fishing, games, archery, handicrafts, and so much more!

Each camper will receive an official Day Camp t-shirt on the first morning of camp. It is requested that each unit provides leadership, one leader for every five boys, with a minimum of two leaders per pack to meet the BSA 2-deep Leadership Policy.

Day Camp is open to all Wolf, Bear and Webelos Cub Scouts, and is traditionally held at a park in the same community your unit meets. Scouts whose parent volunteers their time the entire week attend for free.
